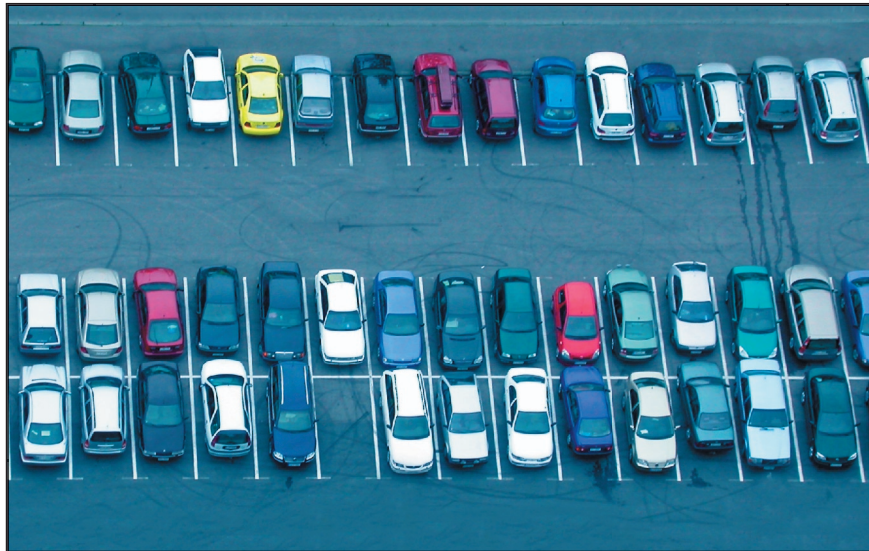


Environmental Assessment for Southern Connecticut State University Master Plan, New Haven and Hamden, Connecticut



Description

Under an on-call contract for Connecticut Environmental Policy Act (CEPA) documentation, as prime to the Connecticut Department of Public Works, FHI was engaged to conduct an Environmental Impact Evaluation (EIE) to examine the potential impacts of implementing the 1993 Master Plan for the Southern Connecticut State University. In addition to covering the full range of impact analyses required by CEPA, the work included a comprehensive traffic and parking study to provide a sufficient level of documentation for a future State Traffic Commission (STC) certificate application and to inform the air quality impact modeling. Other important aspects were aesthetics, compatibility with the community, and state-listed plant and animal species.
