

## Q-Bridge Cultural Resource Mitigation New Haven, Connecticut

### Description

FHI performed a series of cultural resources tasks required to satisfy the terms of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) among the Connecticut Department of Transportation, the Federal Highway Administration, the Advisory Council of Historic Preservation and the Connecticut Historic Commission. Specifically, FHI documented two buildings in New Haven (Fitch Foundry and 166 Bridge Street) to state-level standards. FHI also identified the significant elements of the former Yale Boat House and the Fitch Foundry for potential salvage of building materials. FHI then prepared a website on the history of collegiate crew in Connecticut.
