

On-Call Design Services Vermont Agency of Transportation



Description

As subcontractor to a large engineering firm, FHI provided consulting services for a three-year on-call design-services contract for the Vermont Agency of Transportation (VAOT). FHI played a key role in fulfilling environmental planning procedures and preparing necessary documentation. Within the broad scope of the contract, FHI assisted in the development of scoping reports, conceptual plans, National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) documents, and permit applications. FHI conducted several historic resource assessments and coordinated with the agency's historic preservation coordinator. FHI also orchestrated the extensive public involvement and resource agency coordination procedures set forth in VAOT's Project Development Process Manual, aimed at obtaining consensus on the best possible solution to a problem. Under this element, FHI arranged local concerns meetings, coordinated resource team reviews, organized public information meetings, and developed draft Purpose and Need Statements for a variety of bridge replacement and traffic calming projects
