

Naval Weapons Industrial Reserve Plant Bloomfield, Connecticut



Description

As part of the process to turn the Naval Weapons Industrial Reserve Plant (NWIRP) Bloomfield over to its operators, Kaman Aerospace, FHI was contracted by a major architecture/engineering firm to perform a cultural resources survey of the 84-acre helicopter manufacturing and testing facility. FHI's work included an assessment of the site for significance in the U.S. Cold-War military history and oversight of a Stage 1A archaeological study. FHI's research and documentation revealed that the site was an exceptionally significant Cold War manufacturing facility.
