

On-Call Environmental Services (CEPA/NEPA) Connecticut Department of Public Works



Description

For the second time, FHI was selected as prime consultant by the Connecticut Department of Public Works (DPW) to provide on-call environmental Connecticut Environmental Policy Act (CEPA) and National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) documentation services on a variety of public works projects. Under this on-call contract, FHI provided oversight of DPW's internal environmental documentation compliance process, administering the development of environmental assessments by other firms. Our oversight role entailed ensuring that statutory requirements for CEPA documents were met, reviewing the content of documents, and facilitating coordination and reviews among DPW project managers, sponsoring agencies, consultants, and other state agencies. Assignments included reviewing the MacDougall Correctional Facility Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI), the Camp Hartell Development FONSI, the Bridgeport Superior Court and Center for Juvenile Matters FONSI, and the Three Rivers Community College Consolidation Environmental Impact Evaluation (EIE), conducting a traffic analysis for Bullard Haven, and assisting DPW with floodplain management compliance for the Bridgeport Superior Court and Juvenile Center.
