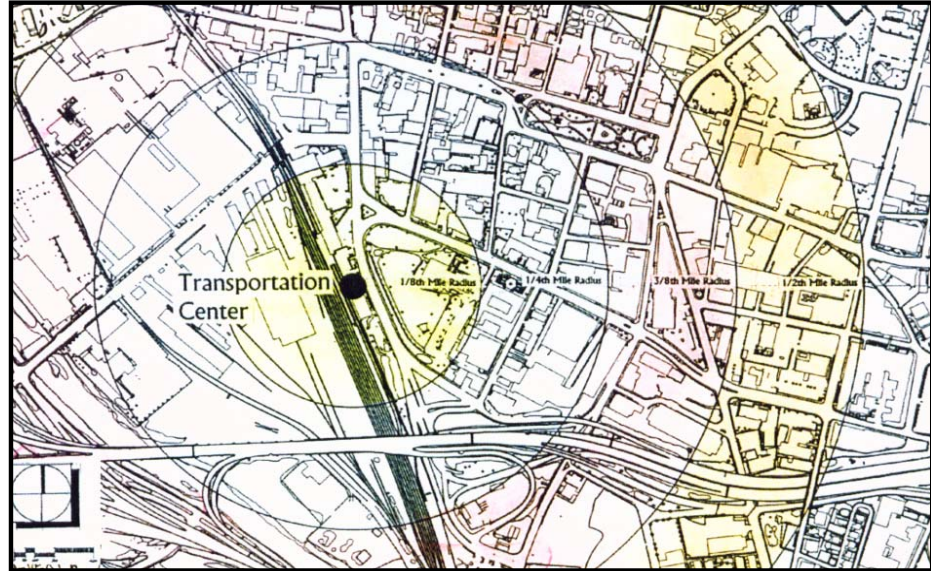


Waterbury Transportation Center Feasibility Study Waterbury, Connecticut



Description

FHI assisted in assessing the feasibility of developing a new intermodal transportation center in Waterbury, Connecticut. The study examined whether an intermodal transportation center would benefit the City and the regional transportation system. It was determined that the local transit system is very fragmented and an intermodal center is both feasible and desirable. Potential locations and preliminary concepts for an intermodal center were explored. FHI assisted in the siting analysis, and conducted a preliminary environmental screening of potential project impacts. The siting analysis considered access by a broad range of modes including pedestrians, bicyclists, taxis, automobiles, buses, airport limousine, and train.
