

## Safe Routes to Schools Maryland

### Description

Fitzgerald & Halliday, Inc. completed work as part of a consultant team on a project to assess conditions at a school in Montgomery County, Maryland as part of a pilot program to develop a guide for the implementation of similar programs statewide. FHI's role on the project included conducting extensive public outreach activities to assess existing barriers to travel within the school boundary, creation of and coordination with a school traffic safety team, identification of recommended improvements to the bicycle and pedestrian network, initiation of parental and community involvement programs and conduct of research to identify private, federal, state and local funding opportunities. The final product of this effort was a guide to educate interested parties statewide on the process and promise of the Safe Routes program.
