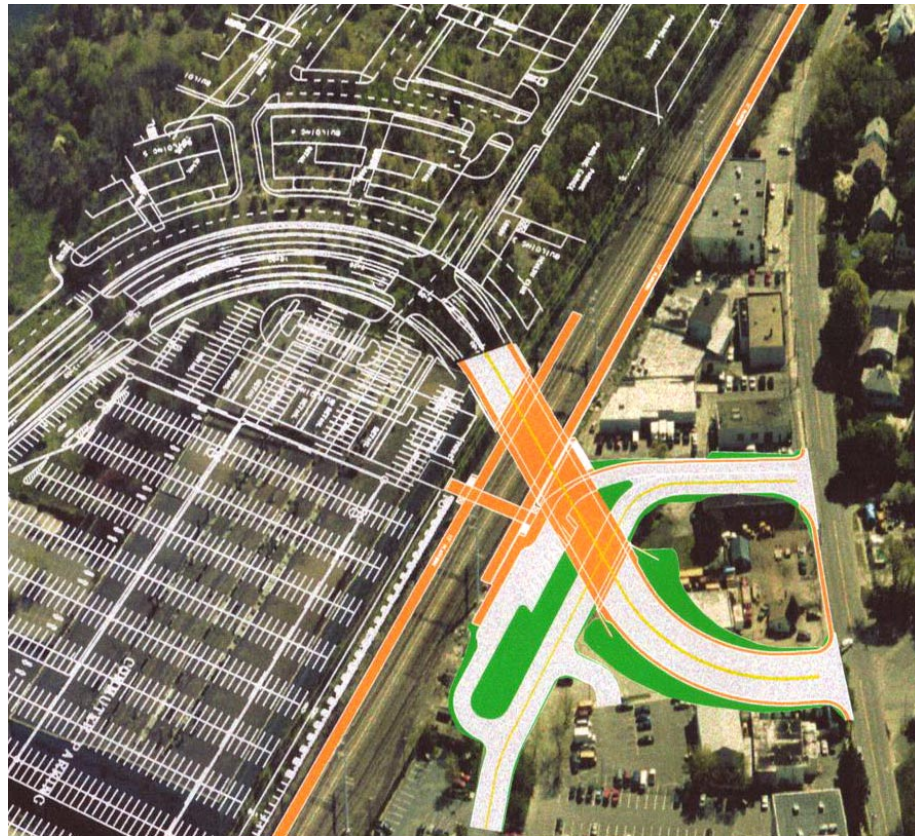


Fairfield Railroad Station Environmental Assessment Fairfield, Connecticut



Description

Under contract to a large engineering firm, FHI is leading the preparation of an Environmental Assessment (EA)/Environmental Impact Evaluation (EIE) for a new Fairfield Railroad Station, pursuant to National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), Connecticut Environmental Policy Act (CEPA), and Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) guidelines. The project includes construction of a new railroad station and associated roadway improvements proposed by the Connecticut Department of Transportation (ConnDOT). FHI's responsibilities include agency coordination, environmental investigations and impact analyses for the full range of EA/EIE issues, and compilation of the draft and final EA/EIE documents. Due to the combination of public and private interests in the station development, the project involves extensive coordination among ConnDOT, station designers, resource and regulatory agencies, the Town of Fairfield, and a private developer.
