

Naval Operations Base Traffic Impact Study Norfolk, Virginia



Description Norfolk, Virginia is home to the world's largest naval installation. As part of a change in practice, the Navy is considering providing on-shore living quarters for sailors while their ship is in port. FHI was part of a project team planning the first phase implementation of this practice, a project consisting of three dormitory style apartments and a 2,100 car parking garage near the base's main gate. FHI evaluated the traffic impacts associated with the change in land use, especially the traffic circulation associated with the parking garage ingress/egress.
