

Delta Air Lines Terminal Replacement JFK Airport, New York



Description

Under contract to an airport planning firm, FHI assessed the historic integrity of one of Delta Air Lines' terminals, the former Pan Am building, which needed to be enlarged and modernized. Although the New York State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) had initially determined the building to be eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places, FHI's research and assessment determined that the building had been altered over time. Following review of FHI's report, the SHPO rescinded the prior determination of eligibility, since building alteration was not previously considered.
