

Beacon Falls TCSP Project Beacon Falls, Connecticut



Description

FHI was part of a project team to develop a long range planning and development strategy for the town of Beacon Falls, Connecticut. The project was funded through federal assistance under the Transportation, Community, and System Preservation (TCSP) program. The project developed a framework for the redevelopment of the Beacon Falls town center. Goals of the project included increasing access to the Naugatuck River for pedestrians and bicycles, identify development investment opportunities in the town center, revitalize and improve retail opportunities, and improve visual aesthetics and landscaping within the downtown. The project developed an Action Plan of eight primary projects to revitalize the downtown area. Projects included new corner parks, reconfiguration of existing parking patterns, traffic calming, bridge improvements, and improvements to the local train station.
