

## Scenic Roadways Management Plans Easton, Haddam, Harwinton, and Voluntown, Connecticut

**Description** FHI participated with a large engineering firm in the development of four scenic corridor management plans for scenic road segments studied by the Connecticut DOT in Easton, Haddam, Harwinton, and Voluntown. FHI conducted cultural resources inventories in the four corridors to verify the presence of historic resources, locate and map historic elements using GPS and GIS, research historical settlement patterns, and assess the integrity of historic settings. FHI contributed technical memoranda on our findings and participated in charrettes for each corridor to devise and recommend strategies for preserving historic structures in each corridor. Based on the location and characteristics of existing scenic resources, the corridor management plans establish protocols for handling increased travel demand while preserving the unique character of the four corridors.
