

Hartford Neighborhood Traffic Calming Hartford, Connecticut



Description

FHI played a leading role in public outreach during development of a citywide traffic calming plan encompassing all of Hartford's neighborhoods (population 120,000). The plan was developed in concert with public input from a series of community design charrettes. FHI's objective was to maximize the number of stakeholders participating in the planning workshops. Outreach was accomplished through promotion of public involvement to community leaders and groups, organization of neighborhood outreach committees, and wide publication of meetings through the press, including radio, newspapers, and television. Additional tasks included organizing focus groups, assisting with group meetings and charrettes, identifying neighborhood issues and resources, evaluating responsiveness of proposed traffic calming measures to community concerns, working with traffic calming committees and writing and editing sections the final traffic calming master plan report.
