

Killingly Quarry Site Plan Review Danielson, Connecticut



Description

A quarry was proposed in a Mixed-Use Interchange zone set aside specifically for interchange-related commercial development at I-395 in Killingly, Connecticut. FHI was contracted by a neighborhood group to provide an analysis of a Special Permit application and associated site plan for this quarry, exploring potential community and natural resource impact issues associated with quarry activity. In addition, FHI explored development options for a sustainable mixed use of the site and prepared a concept plan as an alternative to use for a long-term quarry operation. FHI's successful presentation of findings to the Killingly Planning and Zoning Commission led, in part, to their ultimate decision to deny the quarry application and to deny a related request for a change to the zoning regulations that would have eased future applications for quarry operations in a Mixed-Use Interchange Zone.
