

Plan of Conservation and Development Update Woodbridge, Connecticut



Description

FHI is partnering with another firm in updating the Plan of Conservation and Development for the rural town of Woodbridge, Connecticut. Woodbridge is intriguing as a Connecticut municipality in that it is a pastoral community, yet is on the edge and influenced by the New Haven urbanizing area. The Plan of Conservation and Development update process will result in community consensus on current goals, objectives, and policies for the physical and economic development of the town. Contemporary community issues being addressed in the plan include preservation of community character, conservation of open space, cluster residential development, enhancement of a distinct Village District, and evaluation of community infrastructure, in particular the transportation system. FHI is responsible for the transportation element of the plan, examining current conditions on Woodbridge's street system, identifying community concerns with traffic and travel, and drafting recommendations for future changes and improvements. As part of this effort, FHI also helped to conduct a community workshop to define current issues and determine goals for the future.
