

Wethersfield Historic District Survey Wethersfield, Connecticut



Description

FHI was contracted by the Connecticut Historical Commission and the Town of Wethersfield to prepare an Architectural Resource Survey for the Wethersfield Historic District. Wethersfield is one of Connecticut's first incorporated towns and the historic district contains some of the most distinguished and well-preserved examples of Early Colonial style architecture in the state. FHI prepared a state-level historic resource survey form for each of the 1,100 properties in the district with an accompanying general history narrative. The survey forms, containing a description and brief history of each property, were created by FHI using FormDocs software, enabling the forms to be readily available to the general public in electronic format through the Town's database.
