

## Central Connecticut State University Master Plan New Britain, Connecticut

### Description

As an assignment under our On-Call Environmental Documentation Contract with the Connecticut Department of Public Works (DPW), FHI was asked to review the Environmental Impact Evaluation (EIE) for the Central Connecticut State University (CCSU) Master Plan. The Master Plan was completed in 1999 and entailed approximately 34 projects. The impacts of the various phases of the Master Plan were described in the EIE, which was prepared by another consultant. FHI provided review of the content, logic, and presentation of the EIE with the purpose of ensuring that the document fulfilled the requirements of the Connecticut Environmental Policy Act (CEPA), including addressing the issues raised by the public scoping process, the required impact analyses, and suitable mitigation measures. In addition to assisting DPW comply with CEPA requirements, FHI was on-call to assist with distribution of the document and with conducting a public hearing.
