Description

FHI was selected to develop and coordinate the public involvement program for this regional intermodal connections study and collect data through surveys of visitors to tourist attractions, including casinos. The study encompasses examination of alternatives for enhancing transit services, including bus, rail and ferry, to improve mobility to attractions in southeastern Connecticut. FHI is facilitating involvement of the transit agencies and the public through orchestrating advisory committee meetings, facilitating public meetings and a partnering workshop, designing a project website, and arranging focus meetings with key stakeholders. FHI is assisting with user surveys to evaluate travel demand and behavior.
