

## Route 34 Transportation Study Derby, Connecticut

### Description

For the Naugatuck Valley Council of Governments and the Connecticut Department of Transportation (ConnDOT), FHI is completing a two-phased corridor study of Route 34 through Derby. Phase I of the study is the complete inventory and traffic operation and safety assessment of existing conditions with short-term recommendations to address existing corridor deficiencies. Corridor improvement recommendations included lane redesignation, signal retiming and rephasing, construction of a closed loop signal system, and signal coordination. Phase II of the study takes into account a 20-year horizon of traffic growth and land development changes, to guide a regional master plan for the corridor and Downtown Derby. The study and the regional master plan are both designed to address the corridor travel needs in concert with the economic development desires of the City.
