

Newhall Neighborhood Project Public Involvement Coordination



Description

FHI has been selected by the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) to assist in the design and implementation of a public involvement program for the Newhall Neighborhood Superfund Site in Hamden. The DEP is the lead agency in resolving issues arising from the discovery of contamination in the Newhall neighborhood. FHI's role is coordination of public involvement activities while DEP oversees investigation and remediation of affected properties. FHI's responsibilities include planning, organizing and preparing visual materials for community meetings, writing newsletters, flyers and other publicity materials, meeting with stakeholders and committees, establishing a database and community repository for project documents, preparing summaries of technical documents in lay terms, and designing/maintaining a project website.
