### Description

Fhi was selected by the the Preservation Services Bureau of the New York State Office of Park, Recreation and Historic preservation to prepare 65 national Register Nominations for New York City Subway Stations. The work is being performed on a rapid timetable (completion in six mnths) to meet the requirements of the funding agency, the MTA. As both centennial celebration of the Interborough Rapid Transit (IRT) opening in 1904 and mitigation for impacts from the MTA's station rehabilitation program, FHI staff have been photographing and describing the histories of stations from Brooklyn through Manhattan to the Bronx.
