

Ulster County Long Range Plan Update Ulster Co., NY



Description

The Ulster County Transportation Council, a new Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) in New York State, was federally required to develop a long-range transportation plan. FHI, as a member of a larger study team, was responsible for developing a Public Participation Plan (PPP) for the Ulster County Long-Range Transportation Plan (UC LRTP) and providing guidance in executing the PPP. FHI assisted in the coordination of four UC LRTP Advisory Committee meetings and two Public Workshops for the UC LRTP. The role of the Advisory Committee was to review project work, provide guidance on the UC LRTP, and help with outreach. The Public Workshops provided a critical opportunity for public review and public comment on the UC LRTP process and the plan itself. FHI also assisted with several one-on-one stakeholder meetings, designed to capture information from key members of the Ulster County transportation community who were not involved with the Advisory Committee or who did not attend the Public Workshops. In working with the Advisory Committee, coordinating the Public Workshops, and meeting with stakeholders, FHI prepared meeting agendas, facilitated discussion, prepared handouts and a questionnaire, and developed a press release and a flyer for advertising purposes. FHI has also contributed to meeting presentations. Additionally, FHI created and is maintaining a project website.
