

Danbury Police Station Danbury, Connecticut



Description

The City of Danbury, Connecticut proposes to construct a police station on the northeast corner of Main Street (State Route 53) with Garamella Boulevard in Danbury, Connecticut. The station features approximately 75,000 square feet of building space to be used for administrative and operations offices, a community center, and a two-level parking garage.

Fitzgerald & Halliday, Inc. (FHI) was retained to conduct a traffic study to assess the traffic impacts associated with the proposed development. The traffic study quantified existing traffic and roadway conditions, forecasted anticipated traffic and parking demands associated with the development, and identified traffic mitigation measures to ensure safe and efficient access and egress to the development. FHI was also tasked with the coordination efforts for obtaining state approval of the development from the Connecticut State Traffic Commission.
