

Gateway Community College New Haven, Connecticut



Description

Fitzgerald & Halliday, Inc. (FHI) is preparing an Environmental Impact Evaluation (EIE) for the proposed relocation and consolidation of the two existing campuses of the Gateway Community College (GCC) to Downtown New Haven, Connecticut; one campus is now located on Sargent Drive in New Haven and one on Bassett Road in North Haven, Connecticut. GCC is currently one of the fastest growing colleges in the state.

The purpose of the project is to significantly improve the educational experience of students by providing a consolidated, state-of-the-art College that fosters a sense of community for them, and which is strongly connected with New Haven's educational, biomedical, cultural, economic, and social institutions and settings. The new campus will include approximately 360,000 gross square feet of building space. This project is unique in that it involves a complex working relationship among Connecticut State Department of Public Works (DPW), the College, Board of Trustees of Connecticut Community Colleges, and the City of New Haven. Substantive issues the EIE will explore in depth include potential impacts to traffic, parking in Downtown New Haven, and socioeconomic and community effects.
