

## South Norwalk Rail Station Intermodal Facility Study South Norwalk, Connecticut

### Description

The South Norwalk train station in Norwalk, Connecticut once had the dubious reputation of being the worst station on the MetroNorth system in terms of the facility conditions and safe access. The station has been improved over time, including a new parking garage, yet the original station building remains and does not adequately serve commuters or integrate well within the neighborhood. Fitzgerald & Halliday, Inc. (FHI) is contributing to the planning and design of enhancements to the South Norwalk or SoNo train station to transform it into a contemporary intermodal center.

The project goal is to provide a functional, cost-effective, fully integrated Intermodal Facility in the City of Norwalk at the South Norwalk Railroad Station; one that will meet all the environmental, operational, building and fiscal requirements. FHI's roles are conducting a public outreach program that is truly inclusive for all the diverse project stakeholders and a screening of environmental resources. Project stakeholders include neighborhood residents, commuters, the local business community, and the City of Norwalk as a whole. Information from the environmental screening process will provide critical data essential to the decision-making process on the project's design.
